This PDP accreditation is a testimony to Digipharmacie's technical expertise and commitment to supporting its customers in meeting the e-invoicing requirement scheduled to take effect starting in 2026.

A strategic acquisition to support electronic invoicing

This PDP status represents a key milestone for Digipharmacie, which will now be able to:

- Issue, transmit and receive electronic invoices,
- Ensure regulatory compliance in terms of e-reporting and data transmission to tax authorities,
- Offer customers reliable, secure and interoperable solutions specifically adapted to their needs.
